

## **Fortune's Fool COVID rules and regulations for "To Breed or not to Breed"**

No rehearsal or production meeting shall be done in person; they will be conducted virtually via Zoom.

For both tech and performances, no performers will be onstage together unless they are part of the same household.

All performers will be masked until the moment of speaking into the microphone. Each performer will put a disposable shield on the mic before they speak and take it off when they leave.

Music will be played between performances to give enough time for safe transfer of performers on and offstage without interaction.

All performers and staff will monitor themselves for any symptoms. Audience members will be required to self-screen for symptoms before entering the space. We will take the temperature of all staff, artists, and audience members with a touchless infrared thermometer. Should they have a significant temperature or display any potential COVID-19 symptoms, artists will not be allowed to perform, staff will not be allowed to work, and audience members will be turned away, unless they have had a negative test result. We will rearrange performance scheduling for individual artists as necessary if this occurs. Audience members will be offered the choice of exchanging their tickets for a performance after their fever is gone, or having their purchase refunded.

During, before, and after performances there will be no eating, frequent handwashing, and masks for the entire time staff and artists are in the theatre facility.

The dressing room and performance space will be disinfected daily before and after performances including a wipe down of all chairs and doors and light board. Seating both in the green room and the house will be arranged to maintain proper social distancing.

There will be no props or costumes. Performers will perform in the clothes they arrive in. There will be no curtain call. Performers will not mingle with patrons.

Masks will be required of all audience members, tech, and front of house staff. Front of house staff will, in addition, wear plastic face shields. Audience members will be required to enter current contact information to book tickets for potential contact tracing purposes.

Payment will be prepaid online with credit card, PayPal, or venmo only; no contact. No concessions. The lobby will be arranged for proper social distancing and it will be enforced.

Performance length is approximately 45 minutes to reduce the need for bathroom usage by patrons. Bathrooms will be completely disinfected before and after every show.

We will seat and exit audiences in order to maintain proper social distancing at all times. Audience will follow the state guidelines of 25% capacity. The 80-seat house will be capped at 16 prepaid and 20 total audience members.
